

## WHO ARE THE CHRISTADELPHIANS?

The word Christadelphian is taken from the Greek and simply means 'Brothers in Christ' for Jesus referred to his followers as his "brethren". We, as a group of Bible students, endeavour to follow the example and teaching of Christ and so have adopted the name Christadelphian.

We accept the Bible as being the word of God, from cover to cover, from Genesis to Revelation, and that it contains His message of salvation. It was written by men who were inspired by God and has been preserved throughout the ages and translated into hundreds of languages.

From the pages of the Bible we discover and believe that God is the creator of all things, including man, and that He sent His only son, Jesus Christ, to be an example for all Christians to follow and ultimately to be the means of salvation for all mankind.

It is God's plan, shown to us in the Bible, to restore peace and harmony to this troubled world and to reward those who have faithfully followed Him when His son returns to this earth to establish His Kingdom.

The Christadelphians are a small group of believers with 'brethren and sisters' throughout the world and from all walks of life. There are no paid officials but rather each member shares his or her skills in whatever way they feel able.

Meeting each week to eat bread and drink wine in memory of Christ's death as instructed in the Bible we try, as best we are able, to follow the teachings and examples it contains.

We feel that the majority of Christians today, whilst sincere, have adopted many of the teachings of man and so the decision to have a separate identity and name.

The words '*Thy kingdom come ...*' are repeated by so many and yet their true significance remains overlooked.

Ours is an open and friendly organization that welcomes your interest. We try to put into practice God's instruction to '*Go into all the world and preach the good news of the Kingdom of God...*' by the publishing of leaflets like this and other activities such as public talks and presentations.
